SPECIAL INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

1. All international students are required to have a baccalaureate degree with a major in nursing (or equivalent of a baccalaureate degree in nursing with a major in nursing). Upon completion of the program, you will be eligible to take the Board Certification Exam. For admission to our program, your transcript will need to be evaluated for equivalency to a baccalaureate degree with a major in nursing. **World Education Services is the only agency that we accept transcript translations from:**

This liability coverage has to be requested **BY YOU**, and **PAID BY YOU (US FUNDS)**. We have no mechanism to pay for this insurance and then bill you.

3. We want to clarify that this is a **VERY INTENSE** program, with many classroom hours and that **ALL INSTRUCTION IS IN ENGLISH**. Therefore, we require that you have a documented score of at least 550 on the TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language).
